UPCOMING FIRST COMMUNIONS

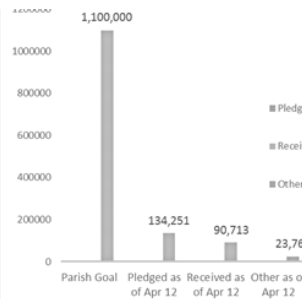

SACRED HEART CHURCH ENDEARS



The "Sacred Heart Church Endears" Campaign continues to thrive. This campaign addresses several financial needs. Our first step is to pay off the Parish Activity Center debt, followed by repairs to the parish building, church hall and rectory. To accomplish this we are humbly asking you to make a sacrificial donation pledge of at least \$500 or more in one year's time. We have faith that if each individual adult made the contribution we would reach the \$1 million goal to maintain and repair our facilities and eliminate the loan debt. A total of 266 contributors have made pledges. \$134,251.00 has so far been pledged. \$90,712.64 has been collected from pledges so far. Other contributions of \$23,765.73 has come from several different sources, i.e., dinners, dances, sales of projects by the adult group, other groups and private individuals, etc. Thus far we have collected a total of \$114,478.37! **Get involved and make your pledge today.** We need you to make this happen!
