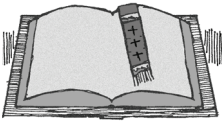

CHARRO DAY



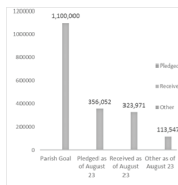
