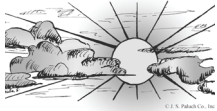

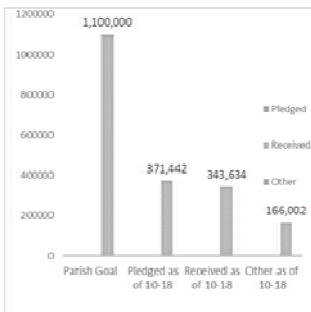

### **ETHICS & INTEGRITY IN MINISTRY**

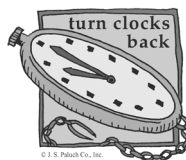
