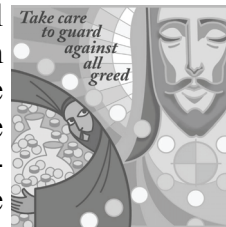
Happening NOW: RCIA & CCE Early Bird Registration for the 2016-2017 school year. Registration after each mass at the CCE Center.
