Registration is now open. Take advantage of the early bird discount and assure your children to have a spot in the class.

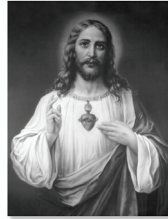

The families of the beneficiaries are contributing according to their possibilities. At present, they have 50 High School boys and 8 college orphans and poor boys and young men in the SABV.
