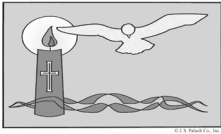

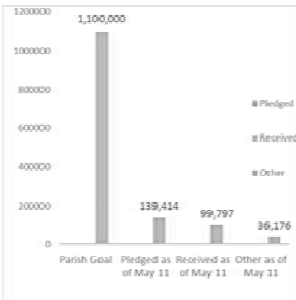

SACRED HEART CHURCH ENDEARS



The "Sacred Heart Church Endears" Campaign numbers keep climbing the chart, but your help is still needed. This campaign addresses several financial needs. Repairs to the church's roof will continue for several weeks, while

other repairs to the church hall have been ongoing. The rectory is also in need some repairs. To accomplish all these repairs and pay the church debt we are humbly asking you to make a sacrificial donation pledge of at least \$500 or more in one year's time. We have faith that if each individual adult made the contribution we would reach the \$1 million goal to maintain and repair our facilities and eliminate the loan debt. A total of **280 contributors** have made pledges. **\$139,414.00** has so far been pledged. **\$99,796.64** has been collected from pledges so far. **Other contributions** of **\$36,175.61** have come from different sources, i.e., cinco de mayo event, dinners, dances, sales of projects by the adult group, other groups and private individuals, etc. The total of pledges and other contributions collected so far: **\$135,972.25!** **Get involved, make your pledge today.** We need you to make this happen!
