BACK-TO-SCHOOL BACKPACKS

This year, Mission Waco is taking a new approach. Their project is now named "Back to School Backpacks". They will offer new durable back packs at a discounted price (80% or more off the retail price) filled with some selected items, for low income families. You can help by donating new durable backpacks, #2 pencils, new tube socks (youth/adult sizes), pens (blue, black, and red ink), hand sanitizer (small bottles) and pocket folders w/brackets. Low income parents will be required to attend a Parent Resource session and then be given a voucher to purchase a new back pack (filled with the selected items listed above) . A filled back pack will sell for \$5 - a discount of 80% or greater. Limit of 4 children per household. The discounted cost allows for parents to provide for their children and shop with pride and dignity. Sales revenue will be used to purchase more backpacks and specified items.
