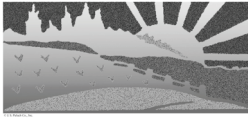

You can also use it for CCE registration or for the Car raffle we have for Charro festival.

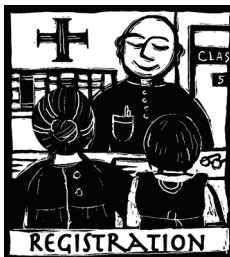

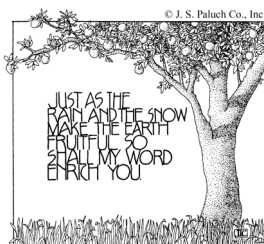
