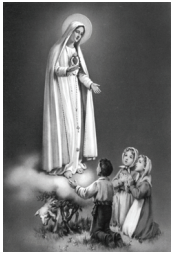

- 4) To make a bow of reverence before your turn in receiving Holy Communion.
- 5) After receiving Holy Communion and arriving at your post, it is good to kneel down and say your personal prayers.
